



# COASTAL TARANAKI SCHOOL

## UNIFORM GUIDELINES (as outlined in CTS School Uniform Policy)

1. Uniform must always be neat, tidy and clean.
2. Hair is to be neatly groomed, with no out of the ordinary colouration.
3. Boys must be clean shaven.
4. Shoes must be worn at all times unless taking part in school activities that require them to be removed.
5. Makeup should not be worn unless for cultural reasons.
6. Jewellery should be kept to a minimum - a single set of gold/silver stud or sleeper earrings. Necklaces and bracelets worn only for cultural or medical reasons.
7. All articles of clothing should be clearly named.
8. Protective clothing, as directed must be worn in specialist areas.
9. Students are required to wear a complete change of clothes for all Physical Education activities.
10. Regulation sport uniform (available from coaches) must be worn for all matches.
11. **Summer uniform - TERM 1 and 4**  
Y0 - Y10 - sandals with school uniform which is the navy shorts or skirts, school polo shirt, school polar fleece;  
Y11 - Y13 - white collared shirts or blouse, black pants, shorts or skirts, black sandals or shoes with black socks (order from the office).  
**Winter uniform - TERM 2 and 3**  
Y0 - Y10 plain navy socks and black shoes, or navy tights and/or plain black or navy scarf with school uniform (as outlined above);  
Y11 - Y13 - black dress skirt/pants with white blouse or collared shirt with school senior jersey (order from the office).
12. Any breach of the uniform code will be managed as outlined in the Uniform Procedures.
